* TEACH Grant has an aggregate limit for Graduate School which is \$8000 total per student.

Requirements for TEACH Grant:

- 3.25 cumulative GPA (OR you may bypass this requirement by fulfilling one of the following)
 - ACT report showing 76% or above in National Average on ONE core battery area
 - A letter from principal stating that you are a FULL-TIME teacher and indicating what you teach.
- TEACH Grant recipient must agree to teach four years (within the next 8) in a low-income school, high-need area upon graduation or at which point the student is no longer enrolled.

Grant applicants must also go to www.teach-ats.ed.gov and complete the Agreement to Serve (ATS) and TEACH Counseling for the current year. These documents must be completed ANNUALLY along with the FAFSA.

Federal Direct Loans are also available.
